


SWAMI TEJOMAYANANDAJI'S MESSAGE

Yellow depicts a positive outlook or vision of life.




Jnana mudra represents knowledge of life and its purpose.



CHINMAYA VISION PROGRAMME

A comprehensive Educational Programme is what makes the Chinmaya Education Institutions 'schools with a difference'. It concretises Gurudev Swami Chinmayananda's vision of education.

Yathaa drishti tathaa srishti-As the vision so the world appears to us.

If man's vision is narrow and disturbed, the world also seems filled with strife. If the vision is broad and love filled, so too is his world.

Chinmaya Vision Programme (CVP) was born to enshrine the philosophy of education developed by Pujya Gurudev Swami Chinmayananda in the heart of every growing child to bring out the best in him or her.

Chinmaya Vision Programme is a comprehensive educational programme for schools which integrates the best in our culture and philosophy of education. It aims at giving children a true vision of life to help them face challenges in a positive and dynamic manner and heartily contribute to the society.

The child is the focal point of this programme. The programme also embraces the school management, teachers and parents. Through them, the light of this vision spreads to the society, country and the world at large.

The Chinmaya Vision Programme can be identified under four heads.

It aims at the overall unfoldment and gentle blossoming of the child at the physical, mental, intellectual and spiritual levels of his / her personality.

Physical Development

Physical development is good for health and proper growth of children leading to the optimum expression of their overall well being. This includes physical fitness, nutrition, hygiene, personal grooming, health education, health assessment, prevention and treatment.

Mental Development

Mental development aims at making the child an emotionally balanced personality thereby helps the child to live in harmony with himself / herself in the world. It includes emotional expansion, handling emotions, mental health assessment and counselling.

Intellectual Development

Man has infinite intellectual potential. Intellectual potential aims to help the child manifest his / her inherent intellectual capacities and enhance existing ones, to contribute positively to society and thereby fulfill himself / herself. It inculcates intellectual kindling, independent thinking, aesthetic assessment and guidance.

Spiritual Development

Man is potentially divine. Spiritual development enables the child to discover his / her inherent divinity and manifest it. It is achieved through value education, philosophy, meditation techniques, etc.

Indian Culture

Culture is more than just art forms, festivals and rituals. Culture is the very way of life of a race and their thinking which makes them unique and special. Under this head, the child is given a wide exposure to the various aspects of our rich culture, cultural awareness and appreciation of vast literacy, artistic and scientific heritage of our country, explanation of myths and traditions and cultural motivation through hobbies, projects etc.

Patriotism

This vital area of focus includes an education in citizenship, civic consciousness, fostering pride in being Indian and National concern such as Unity in Diversity. Patriotism is inculcated in children with the aim of creating dedicated and committed citizens who take real pride in serving the nation.

Universal Outlook

Universal outlook refers to an appreciation, sensitivity and commitment to universal issues. Ancient Indians viewed the world in holistic way, where every being, from the unicellular organism to man, has its own sacred place of pride. After years of mindless pillage of nature, the world needs to come to this universal view of life. The universal outlook helps the child view himself / herself as a responsible citizen of the world (including world issues), live in harmony with creation (environment education and synthesis between science and religion) as well as become aware of being an intrinsic part of the macrocosm.

Chinmaya Vision Programme augments the role of teachers, parents and the management in this ennobling endeavour.

- The teacher is guided into this programme with the help of the CVP Manual, seminars and newsletters. Teachers' assessment scales enable him/her to assess self-worth and effectiveness.
- The parent is gently drawn into the programme through Manuals, parenting workshops, child assessment, self assessment and expert advice.
- The school management through its active participation significantly helps this programme which aims at all-round "man-making" education and not just academics at the cost of other aspects of a child's development.

Thus Chinmaya Vision Programme makes significant breakthrough in the character-moulding and personality development of growing children complementing academic excellence which is what true education is all about.

CVP is not an activity but a vision-inducing programme - the very spirit behind all activities in the Vidyalaya. It is not a 'value add' but the Vidyalaya culture. It is not portion-based, but attitude-based.

CVP is Value Education and Value-based Education. Value Education is when a specific time is allotted for inculcating values through stories, activities, games etc. Value based education is when values are given in and through all the academic subjects and co-curricular and extra curricular activities of the Vidyalaya. CVP is not only value education, but also value-based education.

Chinmaya Vidyalayas are run under the auspices of the Central Chinmaya Mission Trust, Mumbai, in different parts of the country. A managing committee consists of the local members of the Chinmaya Mission and other interested people in the cause of education administers the Vidyalaya in each place.

The school has nursery as well as primary classes in most of the centres. Montessori and other modern systems are adopted in the nursery section. In the primary classes, we follow the curriculum of other recognised schools. The medium of instruction is English.

A growing child, individually unfolds over the years. Stage by stage his awareness and understanding ability and capabilities unfold as he becomes more and more aware of our world and gradually he moves from dim consciousness of infancy through the dreamy days of childhood, to the intellectual awareness of adolescence

We should assist in this awakening process in the healthiest possible way by bringing to the child the right kind of educational nourishment. This is what Chinmaya Vidyalaya is aiming at with sincerity in the best interest of the children and their future and beyond adulthood.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

1. To offer children a value based and holistic education, which paves way for an integrated development of the physical, mental, intellectual and spiritual aspects of the personality, which is enriched by the knowledge of Indian culture and enhanced by patriotism and a universal outlook.
2. To give a practical and judicious combination of academic excellence, extra-curricular pursuits, character building and personality development.
3. To mould children into young men and women of moral strength who can face the challenges of modern life with a smile and make a difference in the world by their positive contribution.

The Vidyalaya is managed by the Chinmaya Mission, Tarapur, on behalf of the Central Chinmaya Mission Trust, Mumbai.

SCHOOL DISCIPLINE

1. Entrusting a pupil to this Vidyalaya implies that parents / guardians agree to abide by the rules of the school. They are therefore requested to read these rules carefully and see that their children also abide by the same.
2. Every student will be provided with a copy of the Vidyalaya diary. All communications of a routine nature from the Vidyalaya authorities will be through this diary only. The diary should be brought to the Vidyalaya everyday. The diary should not be used as a rough book and the pages there in should not be torn.
3. We would request parents to impress upon their wards the need to come to school on time, in proper uniform. If the child is dressed in a clean and neat uniform with the hair neatly combed and the nails clipped and cleaned, it would build up the child's self esteem.
4. All parents, including those of the KG children, should leave their wards at the main gate of the school and are not to accompany them to their class room. This would encourage independence and responsibility amongst the children.
5. No private vehicles would be allowed inside the campus. The parents who bring cars, jeeps or vans are requested to park their vehicles outside the main gate in an orderly manner so as to ensure smooth flow of traffic.
6. The two gates of the Vidyalaya would be closed by 07.30 am. for the Secondary section and 1.00 pm. for the Primary section.
7. No child will be allowed to leave the school premises during the working hours. Parents who wish to take their wards during the working hours will be required to send a leave letter to the class teacher stating the reason. The letter should be signed by the class teacher and counter signed by the Principal.
8. No leave of absence can be availed of without proper sanction in writing, except in case of emergency. When a child has been absent on account of illness, a medical fitness certificate must be attached to the leave note

9. Students suffering from any infectious or contagious disease will not be allowed inside the Vidyalaya.
10. It would be our effort to organize Parents-Teachers Meetings regularly where parents could meet the teachers and assess the performance of their wards. Parents desirous of meeting the Principal or teachers on any other occasion may do so after fixing up a convenient day and time with the school office. We would request you to avoid contacting the teaching faculty at their residence address (either by phone or in person) until or unless the matter is very urgent. Instead you can make it convenient to meet them at the Vidyalaya as said earlier. Parents are requested to use the main entrance and meet the teachers at the reception area near the office, and **not to proceed to the class room.**
11. Parents are requested to inform the class teachers about any change in their address or telephone numbers so as to facilitate quick communication in times of emergency.
12. Students are **not permitted to:**
 - a)wear gold chains, long, big gold ear rings, fancy ornaments, rings, nail polish, bangles, anklets, flowers or fancy frills on their hair
 - b)bring costly, fancy articles
 - c)distribute sweets/toffees/gifts on their birthday in the school premises
 - d)bring power driven vehicles to the school on any day
 - e)bring mobile phones to school
 - f)boys are not allowed to keep their hair long or wear dhotis to school
13. Senior boys are not allowed to grow a beard. Being clean and neatly shaven enhances the personality and builds up self esteem.
14. On meeting teachers, whether inside the Vidyalaya or outside students should greet them with 'Hari Om'. Politeness and courtesy are expected from children.

Students should conduct themselves both inside and outside the Vidyalaya with dignity and decorum. They should remember that the reputation of the institution lies in their behaviour.

15. Students are expected to take care of the school property. Damages caused to the Vidyalaya property will have to be paid for.
16. Only vegetarian food should be brought to Vidyalaya. The dining place should be kept clean after food. Children should not litter food in the school premises.
17. Children should move from one class to another in silence, in an orderly manner. Their movement should not be a hindrance to the other classes.
18. No collection of money by students is permitted without the prior sanction of the Principal.
19. Any violation of discipline or of the high ideals for which our Vidyalaya stands for will involve disciplinary action which may include even dismissal.
20. The Vidyalaya reserves the right to dismiss a pupil on grounds of irregular attendance, disobedience to teachers and any kind of malpractice or objectionable behaviour or conduct, not in keeping good tone of the school inside the premises or elsewhere.
21. The CBSE's new assessment policy recommends a continuous assessment scheme which also includes conversational skills. Performance in these tests have proved that students who habitually converse in English have fared better than the others. Hence it becomes all the more obligatory for all the students to converse only in English.
22. Students of one class are not allowed to enter other class rooms during intervals.
23. It is compulsory for the students to attend functions organized by the Vidyalaya for the celebration of Independence Day, Republic Day, etc.

24. The Vidyalaya lays great emphasis in inculcating family values which strengthen the family bonds and glorify Indian Culture. Hence if students are to respect school rules, parents must set an example by attending all Parent-Teacher meetings and special Poojas such as the Mathru Pooja where attendance is compulsory.
25. Class promotions are on the basis of the performance of the pupil. through out the year. The results declared at the end of the academic year are the final. The Report Cards sent to the parents from time to time should be duly signed and returned within two days failing which the student will not be permitted to attend classes.

The Management reserves the right to amend, delete, modify or substitute any of the standing rules.

Girls : LKG to Class II

Frock - Light Blue and Grey one piece - No Belt, Badge on left sleeve. Short ankle length white socks with 1 grey stripe. White Ribbon.

III to VII

Light blue plain shirt with grey divider skirt, belt short ankle length white socks with 1 grey stripe - badge on left sleeve, - white ribbon.

VIII to XII

Light blue kameez with grey jacket (only in the front) grey salwar, short ankle length white socks with grey stripe-badge on left sleeve, - white ribbon.

Boys : LKG to Class VII

Shirt and Half Trouser. Light blue shirt with grey piping on sleeves and front pocket - grey half trouser with a flat over back pockets, white socks with one grey stripe-belt-badge on the shirt pocket.

VIII to XII

Light Blue shirt and grey full trousers. Blue shirt with grey piping on sleeve and front pocket - grey full trousers with flaps over back pockets - belt - white socks with one grey stripe-badge on the front pocket of the shirt.

Students from Std. III to Std. XII should wear white uniform every Wednesday

FOOT WEAR

Black shoes - white socks with a grey stripe. On Wednesday white shoes and white socks with a grey stripe.

During rainy days, all students shall use rainy wear of black colour
No other type of footwear will be permitted.

Note: The uniform should be of the prescribed shade and pattern only. No other colour / shade / pattern will be permitted.

GENERAL

Boys must cut their hair short and girls must tie their hair neatly with white ribbon. Parents are requested to see that the students strictly adhere to these stipulations. Students who do not come in the prescribed uniform shall not be allowed to enter the class.

ADMISSION & WITHDRAWALS

1. Students seeking admission should produce T.C., conduct certificate, progress report and attendance certificate.
2. T.C. will be issued only on request of either of the parents who had signed the admission form and after all Vidyalaya dues are cleared.
3. A joint application by father and mother should be produced for T.C. where application for admission was submitted by both father and mother.
4. T.C. will be issued only a week after the submission of application.
5. Withdrawals are permitted only at the end of a term. Fees will be levied upto the end of the term, even if a child is withdrawn during the term.

VIDYALAYA OFFICE HOURS

The Vidyalaya Office will work between 09-00 a.m. and 03.00p.m. except on Sundays and holidays.

The attention of pupils and parents is drawn to the following rules of discipline

Behaviour that will warrant disciplinary action:

1. Disciplinary action even to the extent of dismissal may be considered, in the event of misconduct causing injury to others, or causing damage to the physical or moral tone of the school.
2. To inculcate responsibility and respect, children are expected to take care of school property, help keep the premises clean and preserve all materials and books carefully.
3. The students are requested not to participate in any commercial activity (tuition, collection boxes, gifts) with any school staff for any reason, unless authorised by the Principal in writing.
4. No pupil may leave the school premises during working hours inclusive of school recess, without written permission of the Principal.
5. The delay of payment beyond three months renders the pupil liable to be removed from the school.
6. 75% attendance is mandatory. Absences of more than 3 months without permission will be considered for School Leaving Certificate, if the school is not informed.
7. Discipline must be maintained by pupils while travelling on the school bus. Any pupil found guilty of misconduct will not be allowed to avail of the bus facility.
8. A pupil shall forfeit bus facility if involved in damage to the bus property. Besides, the damage done will have to be compensated by the pupil.






